The Washington Post published an article about a sheep in Australia who wandered from his flock and got lost. He was lost for years and consequently, he grew over 85 pounds of wool. He could barely see or walk. Heavy and in pain, he was in danger of dying. And if he ever fell down, the wolves in the area were waiting to devour him because he could not get back up due to the tremendous weight of wool he was carrying. Thankfully, he was rescued and the excess wool was sheared (enough to make 30 coats for adult-sized males), he was fed, cleaned and given the medical attention he needed.

While as humans we are in no danger of growing excess wool, we are susceptible to gaining weight. We gain weight when we hold on to hurt, disappointments, insecurities and regrets of the past. If we continue to stray from our Good Shepherd, these issues will eventually block God's intended blessings and destiny for our lives. Christ has freed from these things and so much more. Let us walk in that freedom, so we may boldly come to the throne of Grace (Hebrews 4:16).

Our Good Shepherd will do whatever it takes to rescue you! He owns all rights, source codes, patents, deeds and blueprints to your life --He knows no failure.
